WHAT THE ROOM TALKED ABOUT

Xi'an Milestone 1 vote opens

After a fast temperature check, Hyperscale's Xi'an Milestone 1 went live as an active proposal with a 940m XRD quorum and seven days to vote. projectShift and Mr. Peanutbutter drove the community to cast ballots, while Daffy clarified snapshot-based voting power.

Community takes over the node stack

Decommissioned Foundation bootstrap nodes broke new installs, so Timan, DefiPlaza, Jazzer9F, tednol and others stepped up with replacement seed nodes. Faraz announced the handover, shambupujar will update the docs, and projectShift confirmed radix.community is the interim domain.

Validators raise fees post-subsidy

With the subsidy over, Ed (RadUp.io) jumped to 15%, Vlad to 10%, austin signalling similar, and projectShift reminded everyone new fees take effect roughly 14 days later so delegators can unstake. Stakers were urged to read carefully.

RAC transparency under the microscope

Austin and Matt Hine pressed the RAC on why legal work stays private, and projectShift defended lawyer-client privilege while promising anything relevant gets shared. Nicolai also pitched a full on-chain DAO framework that projectShift said is too much for the current transition.

From the council & the crowd

What the tracked voices said, and the week's best exchanges.

COUNCIL & INSIDER WATCH

The RAC fielded transparency questions from the community, with projectShift explaining that lawyer-client privilege keeps some work private while anything the community needs will still be shared. Council members confirmed community seed nodes replaced the Foundation dependency and coordinated with shambupujar on doc updates.

projectShift RAC

Urged the Xi'an Milestone 1 vote, confirmed the community-led seed-node handover, defended RAC legal confidentiality, and reminded stakers new validator fees take ~14 days to apply.

Faraz RAC

Announced community seed nodes are in place to support new validators, removing another Foundation dependency, and confirmed the ledger snapshot is around 240 GiB.

avaunt RAC

Clarified merchant-badge requirements for the gateway, promoted Debix's on-chain direct-debit feature, and encouraged pitching SRWA's solar loan to journalists.

flightofthefox (hyperscale.rs) HYPERSCALE LEAD

Pushed back on using the ledger as a database, sketched a Merkle-root + Veilid + DHT architecture for the torrent-index idea, and doubted anyone uses Redstone's Push oracle tier.

"I think trying to treat smart contract platforms like database is generally not the best idea."

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

"How do you download the Radix ledger snapshot without permission or corruption errors?"

Use the Radix-Live aria-based script, which avoids needing extra space for tar + uncompress overhead; projectShift's shortcut is downloading the tar on a separate machine, copying it into the VM, then cloning the synced VM for new nodes.

ONE SIDE

Nicolai argued the ecosystem needs fewer speculative tokens and more real use cases for XRD, treating AI-built launches with suspicion after the Radiant wallet incident.

THE OTHER

Vlad countered that plenty of legitimate Radix devs use AI tooling and what matters is whether the product works, not how it was built.
