Last week Foxy's Xi'an vote passed overwhelmingly and Hyperscale-rs was unveiled, but a procurement debate between Phil Gibson and the room exposed real tension over single-bid funding.

The week belonged to AI-agent payments and an awkward farewell. x402 tooling shipped on Radix while the community rallied around a Cloudflare CEO podcast on machine-to-machine micropayments, but the mood soured as senior wallet dev Ghenadie confirmed his last full-time day and the Foundation's maintenance mode left no clear path for new wallet changes.

WHAT THE ROOM TALKED ABOUT

x402 and the Cloudflare agent moment

xSteele shipped rdx-cli 0.2.0 with x402-style payment flows and a Cloudflare Worker demo, Vlad B updated his Codex plugin to use it, and the Cloudflare CEO podcast on agentic micropayments became the room's obsession. Gary, Timan and avaunt pushed for live demos and outreach to Cloudflare.

An anonymous poster opened a multi-day debate over renaming Radix to escape brand dilution and SEO problems. Vlad B, Adam and Foxy pushed back on cost and timing, while Blablabla, Jimbo and Markus argued the name is already a liability. No resolution by Sunday.

Ghenadie's last day and the wallet vacuum

Senior wallet dev Ghenadie confirmed May 31 as his last full-time day, and the Foundation has been in maintenance mode since May 1 with no process for accepting new wallet changes. Phil Gibson volunteered to take over mobile repo maintenance alongside him temporarily.

Hyperscale milestone 1 funded, Foxy shipping

@Andy.XRD confirmed Foxy received milestone 1 of his Foundation grant in full and is coding ahead of schedule. Foxy spent the week reassuring the community about Hyperscale's design and pace while pushing back on a premature rebrand.

x402 agent-payment tooling shipped on Radix the same week a Cloudflare CEO podcast went viral — the community's best shot at relevance in the AI-agent era.

COUNCIL & INSIDER WATCH

projectShift shared three RAC updates: a Stokenet note, a DAO structuring update, and confirmation that Peachy has clarified his position and is effectively stepping away, no longer blocking KYC for the DAO LLC.

projectShift RAC

Walked the room through Peachy's status and the DAO LLC KYC implications, and argued that microtransactions are the literal foundation of a machine economy.

Confirmed Hyperscale milestone 1 grant is in and work is ahead of schedule; spent the week explaining subintents and Xi'an's light-client proofs, and pushed back on a premature rebrand.

Made the Cloudflare x402 podcast the room's homework, confirmed the Radix wallet code is open source (with a Sargon caveat), and pointed bug reports to the wallet's GitHub repo.

"Until new Xi'an explainers and infographics are written, the existing Cerberus docs remain the best way to communicate the theory behind linear scalability without breaking atomic composability."

Ghenadie RADIX WALLET DEVELOPER (DEPART)

Confirmed May 31 as his last full-time day, said the Foundation has no process for new wallet changes since May 1, and estimated MFA could ship in roughly two months with two full-time devs.

"Foundation is in full maintenance mode since May 1."

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

"How long would MFA, a dApp browser and a fiat on-ramp each take to finish, and at what cost?"

MFA could ship in roughly two months with two full-time devs, but cost estimates depend on the new entity's financing, and he has no experience with the legal side of a fiat on-ramp.

x402 agent-payment tooling moved from spec to working reference: xStelea's Cloudflare Worker demo and rdx-cli 0.2.0 are now in builders' hands, and avaunt confirmed the Radix wallet is open source — though the separate Sargon repo needs a local build before external PRs will land

PENDING**Community adopts a formal procurement/RFP framework**

No formal framework adopted this week; Phil Gibson's procurement concerns still unanswered.

JARGON, DECODED

x402 — An HTTP-style payment scheme that lets AI agents pay a tiny amount per request instead of relying on ads or subscriptions.

Subintent — A small pre-signed payment instruction that one party can hand to a facilitator to finish, enabling agent-to-agent money flows.

Light-client proof — A compact cryptographic receipt that lets one part of the network confirm what happened on another without trusting a middleman.
