Previously: CaviarNine departed, Avaunt Staking's validator closed after six years, and the DAO governance portal went live — with a fierce debate over whether the community would step up to fill the gaps.

The week began quietly with wiki work and spec updates, but ended in shock. A mispriced oracle on Weft Finance let an attacker drain roughly 27M XRD in under an hour — even as the RAC announced that Charter ratification has arrived. In between, a running argument about whether adoption work can wait for the DAO transition kept the room restless.

WHAT THE ROOM TALKED ABOUT

Weft Finance oracle exploit drains ~27M XRD

An attacker exploited a mispriced HUG token oracle on Weft Finance — HUG was priced at ~1,330 XRD instead of ~0.000131 — buying 539K HUG for 70.6 XRD, posting it as collateral, and borrowing 47.28M LSULP and 13.1M XRD before bridging ~27.2M XRD to Ethereum within 45 minutes. Bayesien, Stef and Vlad B traced the attacker's funding to Rocket Pool and mapped...

Wait for DAO or push adoption now?

Phil Gibson argued the community is losing adoption momentum during the 200-day temporary RAC period and asked whether adoption work can proceed in parallel. foxyldady and Bayesien countered that the DAO transition — charter vote, fund transfer — must complete first before budgets and working groups exist, though anyone can volunteer in the meantime.

A mispriced oracle on Weft Finance drained ~27M XRD on the very weekend the RAC announced Charter ratification — the stakes of community governance just became real.

Verifiable finance as a north star

RoterHund shared a discussion paper proposing 'verifiable finance at scale' as a shared direction for Radix as it moves toward DAO governance. foxylady asked flightofthefox whether privacy features like selective disclosure could support the vision; he confirmed viewing keys would be relevant.

projectShift announced that the time for Charter ratification has arrived and asked FarahXRD to pin the announcement in main chat. The RAC also posted its latest community update in the council channel.

Announced that ratification has arrived and reminded the room there is no 'they' anymore — the community must discuss and decide. Also quipped the better question than 'who is selling' is 'who is buying.'

Reported that a pull request for x402 spec inclusion has been submitted and is awaiting review and approval. Also called out that mockery in the chat is constant and tiring.

Confirmed selective disclosure via viewing keys is generally a good idea for privacy on Radix and would support the verifiable finance vision. He also said he's eager to see what the product roadmap turns out to be.

Timan | Astrolescent COMMUNITY BUILDER

Reported the radixdao website worker is moving to Radix's own Cloudflare account, the consultation dapp is finished, and the radixdlt website is now a proper Astro site. Clarified RAC positions are voluntary until someone proposes otherwise.

QUESTION OF THE WEEK

"Does adoption work have to wait for the DAO transition, or can it happen in parallel?"

Funded work is sequential because the legal entity is still the Foundation and the temp RAC's only task is organising the transition — but anyone with adoption ideas can start something voluntarily now and seek funding once the DAO is established.

JARGON, DECODED

Oracle — A price feed that a DeFi protocol uses to determine the value of an asset — if mispriced, attackers can borrow against inflated collateral.

Viewing keys — A privacy feature that lets a token holder selectively reveal transaction details to authorised parties while keeping them hidden from everyone else.

LSULP — A liquidity pool token representing a share of a pool built with Liquid Stake Units — tokens that represent staked XRD.
